The Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ

Whoever eats of my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in them. We now need more than ever to remain in Christ. How my heart aches in our inability to share in the body and blood of Christ but things are reopening-up for us a community of disciples. We are in the process of reopening the church to Masses and sacramental celebrations. Alleluia!

This coming Monday, June 15th we will begin offering daily Mass at 8:00 am in the church. People attending the Mass will enter through the Holy Name Room entrance. You will be asked to sanitize your hands and then sign-in with your name, email and phone number. (We are required to have the names and contact for each person attending so that, if necessary, the public health authorities can do contact tracing.) Seating in the church will maintain social distancing. **Everyone is required to wear a mask** at all times except when receiving Holy Communion.

For Sunday Masses which will hopefully be next Sunday, June 21st we will celebrate a 9:00am English Mass and a Noon Spanish Mass. Reservations for these Masses are required. You will be able to sign up to attend Mass through the Sign-Up Genius reservation system or by calling the rectory and leaving your name and phone number. Details on how to do this will be on the parish website by this Tuesday, June 16th.

We also are still in need of more volunteers to help usher at Masses and sanitize the church after each service. A parishioner over the age of 16 can volunteer. Dear parishioners,

I know that we are all preoccupied with the negative effects of the current pandemic, not to mention the unfortunate expressions of racism which have recently appeared as well, but I want to invite you all to take advantage of this difficult time so that we may grow spiritually as a community.

Towards that end, I wish to invite you to consider participating in one of two sets of faith-sharing groups that will be starting in the first week of July and will run through the month of August. These sessions will initially be offered in English through ZOOM online meetings.

- **“Creating Sacred Habits for Self and Others”**: The first set of small faith-sharing groups will focus on the spiritual habits (of attention, of prayer, of spiritual conversation, of fasting and of journaling) during these COVID-times.
- **“Faith and Racial Justice”**: The second set of small faith-sharing groups will be meeting around the topic of racism. These particular groups will engage in a reflection on the underlying causes that generate the racial tensions in our country and explore how we might contribute, by means of our faith, to foster reconciliation at this time.

The groups will meet 8 times (once a week during the months of July and August). Father Dan, along with Paul Phillipino, SJ (one of the Jesuits in training) have offered to facilitate the different groups. The materials we will be using are from the JustFaith programs that have served the Catholic community for over 20 years. Their materials are excellent!

In order to foster deeper sharing, we will keep the number of persons in each group to six, but we can have as many groups as there are people that sign up. When you do sign up, please indicate: (1) which of the two programs you would prefer to be involved with and (2) is it easier for you to meet in the morning, afternoon or evening.

We hope a good number of our parishioners take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to learn and to build community together. In fact, this might prove to be an excellent way for us to lean into the Adult Faith Formation Center we have been envisioning for our parish as one of the outcomes of our participation in Renew My Church.

Our groups will meet weekly during the months of July and August. As long as you have access to Wi-Fi, we can meet virtually via Zoom. As soon as circumstances warrant, we can meet face-to-face in the Holy Name Room. You will be sent the materials that are going to be discussed for each session.

So, please, give this matter some serious consideration. To register please email: Paul Phillipino, SJ: paul.phillipino@gmail.com letting him know which of the programs you would prefer to attend and what time of day works best for you. Besides providing a fine way for us to keep connected during the pandemic, these programs promise to help us grow spiritually.
